



PITT MEADOWS COMMUNITY SPORTSFIELD CONSTRUCTION UPDATE As of August 2010

Construction took place over the summer of 2010



Completion was scheduled for mid-August to allow user groups to use the field for summer sports and practices



The Pitt Meadows Artificial Sports Field is located at Pitt Meadows Secondary

After five years of planning, Pitt Meadows' artificial turf field has officially opened with the first game played on the field on Monday, August 16, 2010. The field will allow for events in all types of weather such as soccer, lacrosse, and Pitt Meadows Secondary School's Marauders football program.

The improvements include a sport field lighting system that represents the latest technology in energy conservation and light distribution, allowing play to continue until 10:00pm. Other amenities to be constructed in the coming months will include spectator seating for 300 and public washrooms. A walking trail has been constructed around the perimeter of the school yard with connections to Pitt Meadows Athletic Park and the existing neighbourhood.

This artificial turf field has been made possible through funding contributions from the Government of Canada and Province of British Columbia's Building Canada- Communities Component, The City of Pitt Meadows, School District No. 42 (Maple Ridge-Pitt Meadows) and the Pitt Meadows Soccer Club.
