BYLAW NO. 2383, 2008.**

A Bylaw of the City of Pitt Meadows to for the Payment of Remuneration to Council  
Members

---

**WHEREAS**, Council wishes to set, by Bylaw, the level of remuneration and benefits available to elected officials;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the City of Pitt Meadows in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

**Citation/Title**

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "**City of Pitt Meadows Council Indemnity Bylaw No. 2383, 2008.**"

**Council Indemnification**

2. The Mayor shall be paid remuneration for discharge of the duties of office in the amount of Four Thousand, One Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$4,133) per month from the 1st day of January, 2009. The subject remuneration shall be reviewed and adjusted on January 1st of each year to 75% of the published median salary of all Metro Vancouver mayors for the immediately preceding year.
3. Each Councilor shall be paid remuneration for discharge of the duties of office in the amount of One Thousand, Five Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$1,550) per month from the 1st day of January, 2009. The subject remuneration shall be reviewed and adjusted on January 1st of each year to 37 ½% of the Mayor's salary as set out in section 2 above.
4. An Acting Mayor, appointed by the Council under Section 130, of the "*Community Charter*", shall be paid remuneration for discharge of the duties of office in the amount of 10% of the monthly Mayors salary as set out in section 2 above, in addition to the remuneration paid to all Councillors.
5. One third (1/3) of the remuneration to be paid to the Mayor or to a Councilor shall be a non-accountable allowance for expenses incurred for business use of a private automobile, meals, entertainment, Canadian travel, home office materials and equipment, cellular phone, and other G.S.T. taxable goods and services which are incidental to the discharge of his/her office, other than those expenses covered hereunder.
6. Payment to a council member for all or part of the expenditures made or incurred by a council member when the council member attends a course or convention, as specifically authorized by Council (either by Council resolution or as included in the Financial Plan), shall be approved and paid as per the City of Pitt Meadows Travel and Training Policy.

7. Council members shall be provided with Accidental Death and Dismemberment ("A.D.&D.") benefits while travelling on municipal business, the premiums of which shall be paid by the City of Pitt Meadows. The principal sum of the A.D. & D. policy shall be no less than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000).
8. Where a council member is authorized by Council resolution or bylaw to serve in an official capacity on a national, provincial or local organization which is directly related to municipal government and makes expenditures or incurs expenses and are not reimbursed by that organization, payment to the council member for all or part of the expenditures made or expenses incurred by the council member shall be approved and paid in accordance with the City of Pitt Meadows Travel and Training Policy.

**Effective Date**

10. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect as of January 1, 2009.

**Severability**

11. If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.

**Repeal**

12. Bylaw No. 2042, 2008, "Council Remuneration and Expenses Bylaw No. 2042, 2001" is repealed.
