

# SCHOOL LOITERING BYLAW

## Bylaw No. 725

A Bylaw for the Control of Loitering in the District of Pitt Meadows.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows is desirous of controlling the loitering of certain individuals in certain school areas of the Municipality, and is desirous of eliminating nuisances by such loitering;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the District of Pitt Meadows, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the "**The District of Pitt Meadows School Loitering Bylaw No. 725, 1978**".
2. For the purposes of this Bylaw:  
  
"Public School" means a public school as defined in the *Public Schools Act*, R.S.B.C. 1960, Chapter 319, as amended;  
  
"Pupil" means pupil as defined in the *Public Schools Act*, R.S.B.C., 1960, Chapter 319, as amended.
3. (a) No individual shall loiter in any public school or on any public school grounds or on any public property, or any road or highway in close proximity to any public school, who is not a registered student or staff member or assistant of such school.  
  
(b) This section shall not apply to any individual who has a bona fide reason for attending at or near a school on school business.
4. Any person who offends against any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be deemed to be guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw and shall be liable to the penalties hereby imposed.
5. (a) Every person who commits an offence against this Bylaw is liable to a fine and penalty not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and costs.  
  
(b) Where an offence against this Bylaw is of a continuing nature, it shall be lawful for the convicting judge, in his discretion, to impose a fine against the offender, not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each day such offence is continued by him.

READ a first and second time on the 21st day of February, 1978.

READ a third time on the 7th day of March, 1978.
