Fighting Cyber-bullying

Cyber-bullying is verbal harassment that occurs online. It can take many forms, including threatening emails, nasty instant messaging, repeated notes sent to a cell phone, a website set up to mock others, "borrowing" someone's screen name and pretending to be them while posting messages, and forwarding supposedly private messages, pictures, or video to others.

Parents must be aware of their child's online activities to help them avoid being bullied online, or bullying others. Teach kids to always talk to a trusted adult if they are being bullied online. They should never open or respond to

messages from bullies, and should block bullies on chat or IM. And if they are ever threatened with harm, they should call the police.
